



## **go!PEI Outdoor Mapping Project Assistant**

Assists the Outdoor Mapping Project to accurately map publicly accessible trails and spaces on PEI

### **Responsibilities:**

- Using GPS tracking devices, accurately map all trails that do not currently have accurate data (this involves physically walking/cycling the trail system)
- Collaborate with primary stakeholders to create a comprehensive list of all trails and to identify small boat launch points that are publicly accessible on PEI
- Capture photos and videos of the trail system
- Note: this position is highly physical and requires the candidate to walk or cycle a significant number of kilometers in a short period of time

### **Qualified candidates should possess:**

- Project Management experience an asset
- Strong technology skills in website management, mobile device use, presentations
- Highly Motivated and an ability to work independently
- Strong organizational and time-management skills
- Creative thinking and problem solving skills
- Photography experience is an asset
- Must have a valid Driver's License and access to a vehicle
- Ability to cycle and owning a bicycle is an asset
